First ever mega Sri Lanka tourism promotional event in Georgia was organized in Tbilisi, Georgia on 27th September 2023, coinciding with the World Tourism Day.

The event also marked the celebration of 25 years of diplomatic relations between the two countries and took place at the courtyard of Radisson Red hotel, the former post office converted to a luxury hotel recently.

The Guest of Honour for the occasion, Ms. Medea Janiashvili, Deputy Head at the Georgian National Tourism Administration delivered her thoughts noting that this is the first ever such event in Tbilisi, and the importance of the occasion to promote bilateral tourism cooperation in an effective manner.
