Celebrating 75 years of diplomatic relations, Sri Lanka and Türkiye issue Special Commemorative Stamps - 08/12/2023



To commemorate the 75th Anniversary of diplomatic relations between Sri Lanka and Türkiye in 2023, the Embassy of Sri Lanka in Ankara, in collaboration with Turkish Post and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Türkiye, launched Special Commemorative Stamps at the Official Residence of the Sri Lankan Ambassador in Türkiye.

The Special First Day Covers were simultaneously unveiled on December 8th in both Türkiye and Sri Lanka, marking this significant milestone for both nations.

The Special First Day Covers with stamps were handed over by Mr. Menderes Pinarbaşi of Turkish Post and Mr. Murat Dikmen from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to Ambassador Hasanthi Urugodawatte Dissanayake at her official residence. Ambassador Dissanayake then presented the covers to Ambassador Oğuzhan Ertuğrul, Director General for South Asia at the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Mr. Mahmut Uluer, Hony. Consul for Sri Lanka in Nevşehir, and Mr. Vasantha Perera.





The launch of these stamps in both countries was initiated by the Sri Lankan Ambassador in Türkiye, with the Embassy coordinating closely with Turkish authorities and the Philatelic Bureau of the Department of Posts in Sri Lanka for several months to complete the processes.



Renowned artist Mr. Vasantha Perera designed special commemorative stamps for both Sri Lanka and Türkiye, celebrating the 75th anniversary of diplomatic relations. His artistic contributions include 39 unique stamps for the Sri Lanka Philatelic Bureau, focusing on wildlife and nature. The stamps depict iconic locations in each country, namely Sigiriya in Sri Lanka and Cappadocia in Türkiye. The hot air balloons in both stamps symbolize the connection between the two nations, operated by Mr. Mahmut Uluer, also the Hony. Consul for Sri Lanka in Nevsehir.

The Special First Day Cover showcases "Villa Stamboul" in Sri Lanka, built by Sir Mohamed Marcan Marker. The initiative, a first for both countries, received cooperation from Turkish Post and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.





The Ambassador expressed gratitude to Mr. Perera and emphasized the historical significance of this bilateral stamp issuance. Over 50 attendees, including parliamentarians, officials, and ambassadors, witnessed the ceremony and enjoyed Sri Lankan delicacies.
